Thus, instruct your applicant to have a full discussion with a PGP faculty regarding acceptance permission and research plan by the due date of application as specified below.

3. Please note that **the deadline for applications is January 24, 2020.**

4. Priority countries (Southeast Asia, Southwest Asia, Mongolia) :
India, Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Nepal, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, Maldives, Mongolia, Laos

5. After the selection of the scholarship, the admission application and entrance procedure for doctoral Course is also necessary and should be done by the scholar applicant.
