

Funding for International Professors or Researchers Taking Part in the Academic Melting Pot Program

- Expenditure for international professors or researchers taking part in the Academic Melting Pot program is as follows:
 1. Travel expenses, including a round-trip business class air ticket
 2. Allowances of 1,200 THB per day
 3. Accommodation fees, paid at actual cost but not exceeding 2,500 THB per day

In all cases, the total cost for disbursement may not exceed 150,000 THB per person. Costs 1 – 3 above should conform to our institute's announcement (on disbursement for travel, training, and observational study activities B.E. 2556).

- The documents required for Academic Melting Pot applicants are as follows:
 1. Nomination letter to propose the name list of professors or researchers from their faculty/college/campus
 2. Resume/CV from both KMITL and international professors or researchers
 3. Research Proposal

Please submit all of the required documents to the Office of International Affairs (OIA) for preliminary consideration.

- Duration of stay at KMITL of international professors or researchers must be at least 3 weeks.
- International professors or researchers must have completed at least 1 research/review paper with a professor from the institution, which must have been published subsequent to the completion of performance appraisal and which does not exceed 1 year in the SJR index database with journal impact factor.
- International professors or researchers and their counterparts must provide, to the institution, periodical performance reports with evidence showing that their research has been published.
- Within 45 days of international professors' or researchers' research completion, their counterpart must submit the following documents to the Office of International Affairs (OIA)
 1. Expenditure report
 2. Copy of all the receipts of all actual expenses

The counterpart (our institute's professors or researchers) must keep the original receipts for approval.
