The Faculty of Architecture at KMITL is recognized as one of the oldest architecture education facilities in Thailand, having been established in 1971. With facilities covering 128,000 sq.m. of space, and, with 30 study and practical buildings (Arts and Design Library, Ceramic and Furniture Workshops, Computer Labs, Movie Theatre, and Design Research Center), the Faculty is one of the largest on the KMITL campus.

The Faculty serves as a national center for Geo-Social Architecture, Sustainable Design, Design for National Development and has several partnership projects with the United Nations, including “Social Landscape Design” and “Elderly and Disabled Designs”.

Our focus is on developing professionals that are able to contribute creatively to the community by integrating technological architecture with art and design to the benefit of society. Our vision is to create innovative design leaders and to integrate art and science through international-oriented research, with programs that emphasize professionalism and creative learning through hands-on experience.
