

# International Academy of Aviation Industry (IAAI)

In 2014, having participated in the Thai Aerospace Engineering Network, the aim of which was the development of Thai aeronautical engineering expertise for qualified pilots, KMITL announced the launch of an Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot Program for the first time in Thailand. The International Academy of Aviation industry (IAAI) was established in 2016 to support the emerging aviation education programs, aiming to “fulfill the needs for professions in the global aviation Industry.”

The IAAI Faculty aims to produce professionals with the ability to demonstrate a basic understanding of math, science and technology, together with additional mechanical and aeronautical engineering knowledge - graduate students with the ability to use all their knowledge in real-life situations, be eligible in CAAT qualification, possess a bachelor’s degree in Aeronautical Engineering and qualify as commercial pilots.

Currently, the academy is offering two undergraduate programs: a Bachelor of Engineering in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot and a Bachelor of Science in Logistics Management. The graduate students from the Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot Program are trained to apply mechanical and aeronautical engineering knowledge to real-life situations and become eligible to obtain a commercial pilot license under CAAT qualification. Graduate students from the Logistics Management Program are equipped with multidisciplinary knowledge to become logistics experts who possess analytical, technological, and business skills with specialization in air transportation and air cargo.



In addition to degree programs, the IAAI has achieved approval from the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand as an Aviation English Test Center, and in partnership with EALTS - the internationally recognized test of English for aviation - is also recognized by the British Civil Aviation Authority.
