In 1996, this dream was realized with the admission of the first batch of students to the new Chumphon campus to undertake a Bachelor's Degree in Technology Management for Plant Production.

The campus is located in an area close to sea, land surrounded by hills with abundant natural freshwater, making it an ideal place for the studies of Horticulture, Fishery Science and Aquatic Resources and Animal Sciences.
