

COURSES

ESL Communication + English in Use

Use the language skills you have learned in your morning English language class in real-life situations in the community. This course focuses on understanding Canadian culture.

ESL Communication • Web Development

Learn key web concepts and skills for creating and maintaining websites. Additional topics include hypertext markup languages, style sheets, client-side programming, multimedia foundations and dynamic content management.

ESL Communication + Marine Biology

Explore marine life and habitats found along the shores of Nova Scotia. Field trips will take you to sandy beaches, rocky shores, and into the tidal mudflats. Includes an offshore boat trip to see whales and seals.

ESL Communication • Chronic Conditions Management

Examine chronic diseases that impact the growing cost of healthcare. Learn inter-professional approaches to practice and care, emerging models of chronic care and intervention strategies.

ESL Communication + Introduction to Sustainability

Explore topics related to the environment, sustainability and society. Topics include energy use, water and air pollution, climate change and world population pressures.

ESL Communication • Business Communication

Improve the skills you will need for the international workplace. The focus is on written and oral skills for employment.

ESL Communication + Nova Scotia Landscapes (FAFU students only)

Learn about the natural and man-made landscapes of Nova Scotia. Module themes include sustainable development, environmental and ecological impacts, and identification of plants and their value on the landscape.

ESL Communication • Engineering and the Environment

Explore the application of engineering principles to problems related to the built environment, the natural environment and natural resources, and how changing technology affects engineering.

ESL Communication + Teaching in English

Improve your ability to teach the English language or to teach other subjects through the medium of English. This course is designed for experienced teachers at the elementary, secondary and post-secondary level.
