Program Highlights

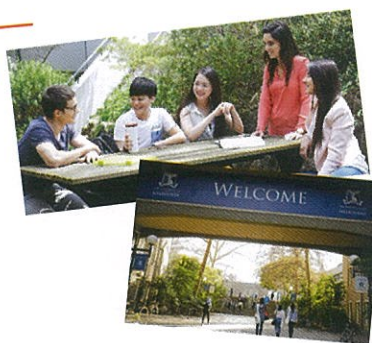
Our 5-week program combines intensive English language classes, in-class activities, with group excursions and activities exploring Australia.

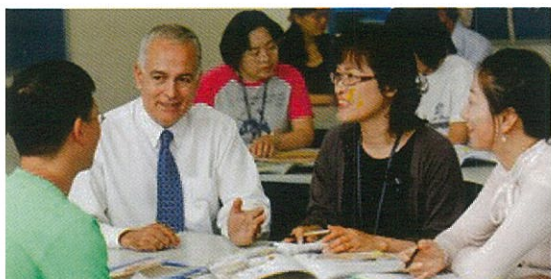
